Keypad Instructions

Key	Description
	Measurment Mode - Long press for 5 seconds to enter the main variable zero.
_	Add one for setting parameters in setting mode, add one for continuous shift in long time.
+	Set Key - Press & hold ▲ + ▼ Measurement Mode - Press ▲ or ▼ key in setting status. Set Mode - Press ▲ or ▼ to set or confirm parameter revision

Advanced User Menu

• Password "0066", Transmitter manufacturer set for display range.


Normal User Menu

■ Password "0016", Set up for special process requirements of transmitter.

Note:

- In the normal user menu setting, if there is no key operation within 60 seconds, the setting will automatically exit and return to Measurement Mode.
- The meter saves all settings only when it exists the Menu normally.

Password Setting Menu

• Lock: Password input menu, if the password is wrong or there is no key operation within 30 seconds, will automatically return to the Measurement Mode.

Parameters in Normal User Menu

Parameter	Range	Description
dSAL Overrange Alarm Switch	O ~ 1	This setting indicates that the display will flash when the pressure value exceeds 125% of the upper limit of the calibration range or is below 25% of the lower limit of the range. "O" - Turn off the alarm function "1" - Turn on the alarm function Default = 0
oFSt Display Offset Values		By setting the value of this menu, you can offset the display value. Default = 0
FiLt Filter Constant Setting	0 ~ 4	The larger the value of the filter constant is, the stronger the interference suppression ability will be, but the sensitivity will decrease. The implied value of this menu value is "2", which is a medium filtering effect and can adapt to most applications. Default = 2
SPAn Sensor Sensitivity Correction Coefficient		In the process of using the transmitter, if the sensitivity of the sensor changes, can be corrected through this menu. Before the sensitivity correction, it should be corrected through the main variable reset function of the zero error of the meter head, in order to ensure that the sensitivity corrected after the linear transmission is normal. Default = 1



Parameters in Advanced User Menu

Parameter	Range	Description
dP Set for Display Resolution	O ~ 1	The display resolution refers to the number of decimal places displayed in the measurement mode, which can be set by the user according to the field use requirements. The more decimal places displayed is not the better, and the stability of the display value should be guaranteed first. Default = 0
dP-L	-1999 ~ 9999	Display range lower limit setting.
4mA Value		4mA - Default = 0
dP-H 20mA Value	-1999 ~ 9999	Display range upper limit setting. 20mA - Enter Maximum Value
ZErO Zero Full Shielding Coefficient	0.0 ~ 1.0	Default = 0
dSAL Overrange Alarm Switch	0~1	This set point indicates when the pressure value exceeds 125% of the upper limit of the calibration range or falls below 25% of the lower limit of the range, it will blink. "O" - Turn off the alarm function "1" - Turn on the alarm function Default = 0
